Meeting called to order at 10:35 am

OLD BUSINESS:

1) A motion to accept the Executive Committee minutes from 01/27/17 was made by Chris Killoren, seconded by Paul Hudson, and accepted by all in attendance.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

- 1) Treasurer report provided by Gail Jones:
 - a. Budget balance sheet was distributed to the members in attendance and is attached to these minutes.
 - b. The Take a Soldier (TASF) fund is current as of 2/28/17.

OLD BUSINESS:

- 1) TASF:
 - a. Confirming sponsorships Pete Knight is waiting on response from Heath Topper with Corning Glass. He has two emails out to Heath with no response as of yet. Working with Town Marine for sponsorship money. Received \$500 from Sithe Energy. Checking on Nationwide, and Classic Windows and Doors. Bill Lamanche is working on getting Herb Phillipson's to provide sponsorship in some fashion.
 - b. Brian Eisch indicated that we are approximately \$3,000 ahead in donations from last year. Blue Rock Energy is paying for the meat for all the barbecue teams. Brian suggested we work with Bass Pro Shops for obtaining approximately 150 rod and reel combos for the soldiers for the event. Contact Baits will be providing packs of lures for the soldiers. Money needs to be set aside for plaques. Brian also recommended setting aside some of the funds for gas cards, etc. for the volunteers.
 - c. Motion made by Pete Knight to purchase the TASF banner from VOSS Signs, seconded by Paul Hudson, all in favor carried.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

- 1) Fishlines Editor: Still seeking someone to fill this position.
- 2) Membership: Paul Hudson, present. Paul reported that all is normal and has nothing new to report.
- 3) Youth / High School: Fred Blom will stay in this position for the remainder of the year.
- 4) Website / Facebook: Currently looking to fill this position.
- 5) Conservation: Barb Elliot, present. Nothing new to report.
- 6) Tournament Director: Dave Repman, present. Dave discussed the proposal for the following rule changes:
 - a. An approved completion of a boating safety course is required as described by the governing laws of the states or provinces in any particular event. Anglers under the age of 18 for a specific tournament must have completed a boating safety course and must provide proof of completion at registration.

- b. Anglers may use only one casting, spin casting or spinning rod 10-foot maximum length from butt of handle to rod tip.
- c. Club Team Championship (CTC) Designated non-boaters are not allowed to use their boat unless either they switch within their team or they are asked to serve as a boater because another team does not have a backup boater. Each club has designated their three boaters to attend and it is expected that the club will provide three boaters for both tournament draw days. Club designation of each angler will be based on the club that angler registered with for the event.

NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) Gail Jones has been elected the new Treasurer.
- 2) Pete Knight discussed projected 2017 budget. Stipend policy revised for all the Executive Committee members. Brian suggested to add \$125 per quarter to drive the fish care boat.
- 3) Fred Blom agreed to stay on as Youth/High School Director for the year.
- 4) Treasurer, Youth/High School Director, Website/Facebook, and Fishlines Editor/Public Relations are open positions that need to be filled.

No further business was discussed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:23 am.
