- 2) Membership – Ken Christie, present. Ken Christie introducing himself as the new Membership Director. Membership cards will be issued once club and member dues are paid. By having this current you will be able to access Vendor discounts that will be coming along. See attached PowerPoint for initiatives for 2020 to grow membership.
- 3) Youth/High School Report – Chris Miscingna, reporting. Chris highlighted the events coming up for the Youth program. We will push the idea of the creation of Junior clubs this year. They will be offering a boater safety course that is open to anyone for free. On the water scholastic program on April 18, 2020 at Onondaga Lake. Thanks to Cashion Rods for sponsoring the Youth Program fundraiser tournaments in 2020. These tournaments are bracket bash style. See attached PowerPoint for additional information.
- 4) Tournament Director – Roxanne Krause, present. Still working on the progress on Roxanne transitioning into the Tournament Director role. We will be getting new weigh-in bags and standings boards for 2020. 2020 tournament schedule presented at the meeting. Additional tournament updates can be found on the attached PowerPoint presentation.
- 5) Sponsorship – Paul Hudson not present. Dave Repman reporting in his absence. Dave discussed the sponsorship brochure and had a few copies on hand for folks to take for potential sponsors. Request to have Dave or Paul send brochure via email to club presidents. An idea was put forth to have potential sponsors buy the weigh-in bags with their logo on them. Plan is to get in line with Bass Pro Shops for additional support in 2021. Please let us know if you know of anyone that can help with sponsorship for 2020 let Paul Hudson or Dave Repman know.
- 6) Conservation – Barb Elliot, not present.
- 7) Scholarship – Chuck Rowlee, present. One scholarship application received.
- 8) 2018 Audit Report – Paul Hudson, not present. 2018 Audit Report completed and discussed findings with the Executive Committee. Fred Blom approves the audit report, seconded by Brady Schoonover. All in favored carried.

## NEW BUSINESS:

- 1) Motion by Fred Blom to make Youth Director part of the Executive Committee as an officer with a revision to the Bylaws. Seconded by all clubs in attendance and carried.
- 2) Dave discussed break into weigh-in trailer and the items that were stolen. These items will have to be replaced.
- 3) Aaron Powell with TNT fireworks fundraiser discussed his program. Tents make roughly 20% on the sale of the products. They offer everything needed for folks to start. Looks for non-profit groups to take advantage of this opportunity. Nothing out of pocket to start and unsold inventory gets returned. At that point you pay for everything that is sold, promotional fee, insurance, visa card reader, ----spend \$8 or \$9 hundred on fees in the end. 6/20 thru 7/5. Vendors license is not required. Non-profit groups do not need to charge sales tax. TNT provided liability insurance for the site. Average tent runs on 1 to 2 people. Age 18 and above to handle the product. Properties are maintained by TNT so there are no conflicts. Training is provided. Tent size is 30' x 60'. Has flyers with him to pass around.
- 4) Tyler Sweet discussed BASS announcement on running a kayak series tournament event schedule for 2020. These events will lead to a championship to coincide with the Bassmaster Classic. Tyler started NY Kayak Bassmasters. He is working with local kayak clubs and NY Bass to hold kayak championship to qualify folks for the championship in 2021. Looking to hold it on Oneida Lake. Needs to be a formal NY State Bass Nation event. Tyler asks that NY Bass handle the management of entry fees and pay outs. Tyler thinks they should expect 30 to 40 anglers for the proposed tourney in 2020. Tournament permits are not required as there is no weigh in or congregation as a group. Proposed tournament date is September 5. Proposed entry fee is \$100 for this tournament in 2020. Dave Repman committed the date of 9/5 for the tourney and will work out the details.
- 5) Regional team discussion: Regional team discounts. 2020 State team members need to email Chuck Rowlee head shot pictures and responses to questionnaire. Further ideas for regional team fundraisers i.e., fish with boaters, etc. were discussed.
- 6) Take A Soldier Fishing (TASF) – Burney Haney present. Praised the participation of the folks in the room. Need more boaters for TASF and stressed they need boater participation to make the program work.
- 7) Fred discussed bylaws that said membership dues need to be submitted by January 1st of each calendar year. He has info for me for the minutes. Extend deadline from January 1st to the March meeting. Proposition is to make the penalty effective after March 31st and the penalty money gets added to the scholarship fund for the NY Bass

Nation stating in 2021. This will be a change to the Bylaws. This will be brought forth at the next meeting in March.

- 8) 2019 Audit Committee announced.
- 9) Next meeting time and date discussed. Announcement to be made soon on a guest speaker.

No further business was brought to the floor.

Motion to adjourn the meeting by Michael Arnt, and Mike Lawton seconded the motion. All in favor carried.

**Tournament Format:** The 1st round (6a-Noon) is a bracket bash format and the required scales are supplied by Cashion. Weigh your fish and if over 3 lbs. then take a photograph showing fish and scale readout. Then release the fish. Document the weight and continue fishing. When you come to the North shore park at noon circle your 5 biggest fish and turn in slip to tournament director. The winner of each bracket will be announced and then the afternoon round will begin with the winner of each bracket in the 1st round. In the 2<sup>nd</sup> round a high school angler will be assigned to your boat and they will become weighmaster and recorder of the weights. The weights will become cumulative in the 2nd round and the afternoon will be total weight of all fish caught.

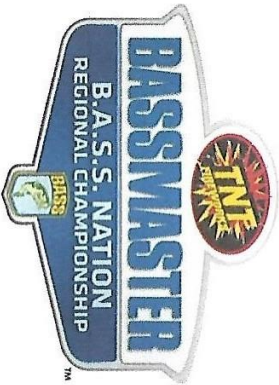

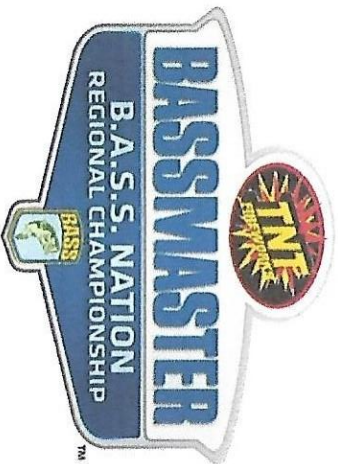
