OLD BUSINESS:

1) A motion to accept the Executive Committee minutes from January 25, 2020 was made by Paul Hudson, seconded by Chris Miscingna, and accepted by all in attendance.

FINANCIAL REPORT:

1) Gail in attendance. We reviewed the Treasurer's report and budget report for 2020. Fundraisers will be a necessity to offset a proposed deficit for 2020.

OLD (Unfinished) BUSINESS CONTINUED:

- 1) Will need to approve rule changes at board meeting.
- 2) Tournament trailer broken into and generator/scale were stolen. New scale will arrive mid-May and new generator end of May.
- 3) Audit Committee meeting for 2019 was postponed due to Covid-19. Look to perform the 2019 Audit by the end of the second quarter. Mail copies in lieu of electronic due to cyber security issues with scam emails to attempt to gain access to our bank account funds.
- 4) TNT fundraiser meeting in June. Dave will attend and ask for someone else to attend.
- 5) Fred review membership due date revision proposition. Will be a change in the By-Laws and needs to be voted on in the Board Meeting.

COMMITTEE REPORT:

- 1) Membership: Ken Christie new Membership Director, present. 21 clubs have re-joined this year. 446 active nation members, does not include submitted or pending at the moment. Need to approach clubs on speeding up the membership response. Really need existing members to promote new membership.
- 2) Youth / High School: Chris Miscingna, present. 4 folks went down to the classic and made some good contacts. BASS youth events have been rescheduled due to Covid 19. Reviewed additional changes due to Covid-19. An online platform called Connect scale is being used. Reviewed sponsor list and updated BASS national youth event schedule.
- 3) Website / Facebook: Gail Jones, present. Club dues can now be paid online Ken mentioned that he heard from clubs if it is possible to pay for multiple members to reduce fee. Discussed making it a one-time fee and will follow up. Dave proposed a zoom meeting with Gail, and Del to post news and other promotions on the website. Goal is to have "fresh" content on the website. Asked for committee members to review their contact information on the website.
- 4) Conservation, Barb Elliot is not present.

- 5) Tournament Director: Roxanne Krause, present. Dave spoke to Union Springs and there are no two-day spots available to hold a tournament which will not work for the CTC on Cayuga Lake. 
<u>Treasurer's Report – Gail Jones:</u>



- We have also made an announcement on Facebook for them.


PROS continued:




