Anglers intending to participate in the CTC must have their membership application to B.A.S.S. Nation and N.Y.B.C.F. submitted and paid by September 1st of the CTC qualifying year and must be a current year member of B.A.S.S. Nation and NY B.A.S.S.

Nation by July 1st of the tournament year

State Team Qualifiers from the CTC: (Four Anglers Will Qualify)

The top boater based on total individual weight will qualify as spot 9 boater

The top boater on the first-place team will qualify as spot 10 boater

The top non - boater based on individual weight will qualify as spot 9 non-boater

Top non - boater on the second-place team will qualify as spot 10 non-boater



Additional Information:

- >Fish limit for Boaters (5) Co anglers (5) of Largemouth or Smallmouth Bass 12" minimum length
- >Tournament waters and License requirements See Page (2)
- >All Anglers must possess a fizz kit and understand how to use it should your catch require fizzing.
- >All Boaters must follow Clean, Drain and Dry Law for official practice and tournament day. No debris on boat or trailer, empty live wells with plugs pulled, bilge plug pulled, and outboard engine should be cleared of any water.
- >Official practice begins Daylight August 11th will close at 3 p.m. on the day prior to the tournament. All contestants must be off the water by this time. It is the responsibility of the contestant to know and observe these dates and times.
- >All anglers must read and know all tournament rules. Tournament rules can be found at www.nybassfederation.com
- >Boaters must present a copy of valid insurance for their boat at re-registration. Minimum \$300,000.00 per occurrence boating liability insurance that covers both the operator and the boat being used in the tournament

Safety first:

- >Observe and follow the laws going through no wake zones. This will be closely observed at send off and at check in
- >Each competitor is required to wear a Coast Guard approved chest-type life preserver. The preserver must be snapped, strapped, or zipped securely and maintained in that condition any time the combustion engine is running.
- >If you are wearing an inflatable life vest, you must have a regular non inflatable life vest on board in order to remove the inflatable while fishing. This is a coast guard regulation.
- >The Tournament Director always has the right to require the use of running lights, and the authority to delay or cancel the start of an official tournament day because of bad weather or other factors that would endanger the safety of the competitors.
- >New Law Requiring Boat Engine Cut-off Switches. As of April 1, 2021, operators of recreational vessels less than 26 feet long will be required to use an engine cut-off switch. This will be checked at blast off

Tournament Waters: New York and Canadian waters of the St. Lawrence River and all rivers, creeks and canals connecting to the St. Lawrence River inside the boundaries listed below. Lake Ontario closed Only water open to ALL public fishing will be considered tournament waters. Any waters closed to public fishing will be closed to this tournament's anglers

Eastern Boundary - Moses Saunders Power Dam. No Locking. You cannot lock through the Eisenhower Lock at Massena, NY. Lake Ontario off limits.

West Boundary at the Mouth of Lake Ontario: Northwest Boundary (Ontario): Concrete Pad in water. 44°12′52.20″ N - 76°31′24.84″ W straight line to – Boat Dock (Wolfe Island). 44°10′54.59″ N – 76°28′49.52 W. Southwest Boundary (Tibbets Point, NY) Tibbett Point Association Boat Ramp. 44°06′28.86″ N - 76°21″59.26 W straight line to Small Rock Jetty (Wolfe Island). 44°07′19.41 N – 76°23′36.38″ W.
